Mr.K.M.Nataraj, learned Additional Solicitor General appearing on behalf of the High Court of Gujarat and High Court of Karanataka states that infosar as the High Court of Karanataka is concerned, the High Court of Karnataka has already put the selection process in abeyance in order to await the decision of this Court with regard to providing minimum number of years of practicing as a lawyer as a pre-condition for appearing for the Judicial Magistrate First Class (JMFC) and Civil Judge (Junior Division).

2. He further submits that insofar as the High Court of Gujarat is concerned, since the procedure is stayed by this Court, the similar notification has already been issued.

3. In that view of the matter, nothing remains for consideration in the present application.

4. The application is, accordingly, disposed of.”
