UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and carefully perused the material placed on record.
2. We see no reason to entertain the present Writ Petition, which has admittedly been filed directly before this Court under Article 32 of the Constitution of India. We say so being of the considered opinion that the petitioner has an alternative efficacious remedy, i.e., approaching the High Court of Kolkata under Article 226 of the Constitution.
3. The Writ Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
4. If the petitioner perceives any threat to his life and liberty, he may file a petition online before the High Court. The hearing in the said petition can also take place through video

conferencing. For this purpose, we direct the Registrar General of the High Court of Kolkata to extend such facilities to the petitioner.

5. As a sequel to the above, the pending interlocutory application also stands disposed of.
