Through the present application, applicant-petitioner is seeking concession of interim bail for a period of four weeks for the purpose of sowing agriculture crops for the next crop session which is sole base of livelihood for the applicant-petitioner.

Counsel for the State does not dispute the ground of interim bail, but submits that interim bail may not be granted.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon powers of this Court to grant bail, this Court is not inclined to grant interim bail to the applicant on the ground mentioned in the application, as there may be some other family members to sow the crops. Moreover, if he is granted interim bail to sow crop, in that case, who will look after the crop after that?

Given above, no ground is made out to grant interim bail and CRM is dismissed.
