ORDER

- 1. Leave granted.
- 2. We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.
- 3. The appellant has been arraigned as an accused in ECIR Case No.01 of 2023 [arising out of ECIR/RNZO/18/2022 dated 21.10.2022, arising out of Bariatu P.S. Case No.141 of 2022] for offences punishable under Section 3 read with Section 70 and punishable under Section 4 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002.
- 4. Admittedly, the appellant has been under incarceration for 2½ years. From the records, we gather that the trial would take considerable length of time, though it has been commenced.
- 5. Considering the above, we are inclined to set

aside the impugned order and grant bail to the appellant.

- 6. Accordingly, the impugned order stands set aside and the appellant is granted bail, subject to the terms and conditions that may be imposed by the Trial Court.
- 7. The appeal is allowed, accordingly.
- 8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
